For my capstone project at Trinity Christian School, I chose to research why we as Christians have a responsibility to help the impoverished without hurting them more in the process.

Jesus says, "As you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me." In a desire to fulfill this command and apply my thesis, I will be hosting a food pack with the entire high school.
